Further to my last letter we have held our meeting of the 7th Feb, and I think everyone who attended agrees it was a very successful evening. The success was, to a large extent due to Ken Dyer, and of course his wife who supplied the coffee and biscuits, which helped towards a very comfortable evening.

We had recieved a programme from the sailing section for 1985, and so we made this our first item for discussion.

It appears the following dates will be used for all day sailing; Feb 17th, April 14th, May 12th, June 9th, June 23rd and July 28th. All day regattas sail and scale June 30th and September 29th. Apart from these dates, scale will have all other Sunday mornings Sunday afternoons are now out for scale.

The purpose of this meeting was of course, to promote enthusiasm for competitive event at the regattas. It was decided to compete for our existing trophies and therefore we would have a steering competition for the Shield, and Tug Towing for the Cup.

It was suggested that we should have teams of three for the tug towing, held over three days with a time limit.

The steering competition for the Shield would be held over 5 days, with a set time limit and best marks for 3 runs being the winner. The models would be awarded marks before competing, and then marks deducted for faults over the course, Jack Fry and Ken Dyer are to be our judges.

It was suggested by Ernie Powell that with our present membership, and numbers attending Setley, it will be possible for each member to have his own frequency. This idea was readily excepted by the meeting.
